*This vessels is dated to the Iron Age (1200-586 BC). This period, also known as the First Temple period, is one of the most important periods in the Jewish and Biblical history of the Holy Land: Its importance stems mainly from the important role of the First Temple and the work of sacrifice in Jerusalem.*

*The juglet is an example of an everyday vessel that was used by the people of Judea during the First Temple period. The small dimensions of this jug apparently indicate the fact that it contained some precious oils.*
