CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- 1980—Established himself as one of the best and most exciting players in baseball, leading the AL in stolen bases and finishing 4th in runs. Was the club leader in average, runs, hits, doubles, stolen bases (100).
- 1979—Recalled by A's from Ogden, June 23, and finished season in majors, hitting .274 over 89 games. Led the A's in stolen bases with 33. Was hitting .309 for Ogden at time of his recall.
- 1977 In 2nd pro season, hit .345 for Modesto in 134 games and on May 26 became only the 4th player in professional history to steal 7 bases in one game.
