The all-around "park camber" profile and blunted shape of this ride make this board comfortable on natural or man-made features. This is an all-around board designed for all-mountain and freestyle, with the beginner to intermediate rider in mind. The logger features hand-drawn bark and the preferred tool of any backcountry woodsman, the hand axe. At 158 cm, this is a good beginner to intermediate board for a rider in the 5'9" to 6'2" tall, 160 – 200 pounds weight range (this would be an upper beginner to low intermediate for a rider at the upper end of that size range, a solid intermediate for a rider at the lower end of that size range. Board is brand new, still wrapped in clear plastic protective cover. Does not include bindings, but The Ski Renter can provide a used set if purchaser would like. Includes travel bag. Note: shorter boards are slower and easier to control, longer boards are faster and require more skill to control.
