The Denver Broncos selected **Steve Atwater** out of Arkansas in the first round, 20th choice overall, of the 1989 NFL Draft. A hard-hitting and instinctive safety, Atwater played in 167 games during his 11-season career.

He made an immediate impact at free safety in his rookie season. Atwater recorded 129 total tackles (2nd most on the team) to help turn around a Denver defense that ranked 20th in points allowed the previous year to become the NFL's stingiest unit in 1989 that allowed the fewest points in the league. The Broncos finished

that season with the AFC's best record at 11-5 and a berth in Super Bowl XXIV.

Atwater was voted to the first of eight Pro Bowls following the 1990 season and earned first-team All-Pro recognition for the first time in 1991.
