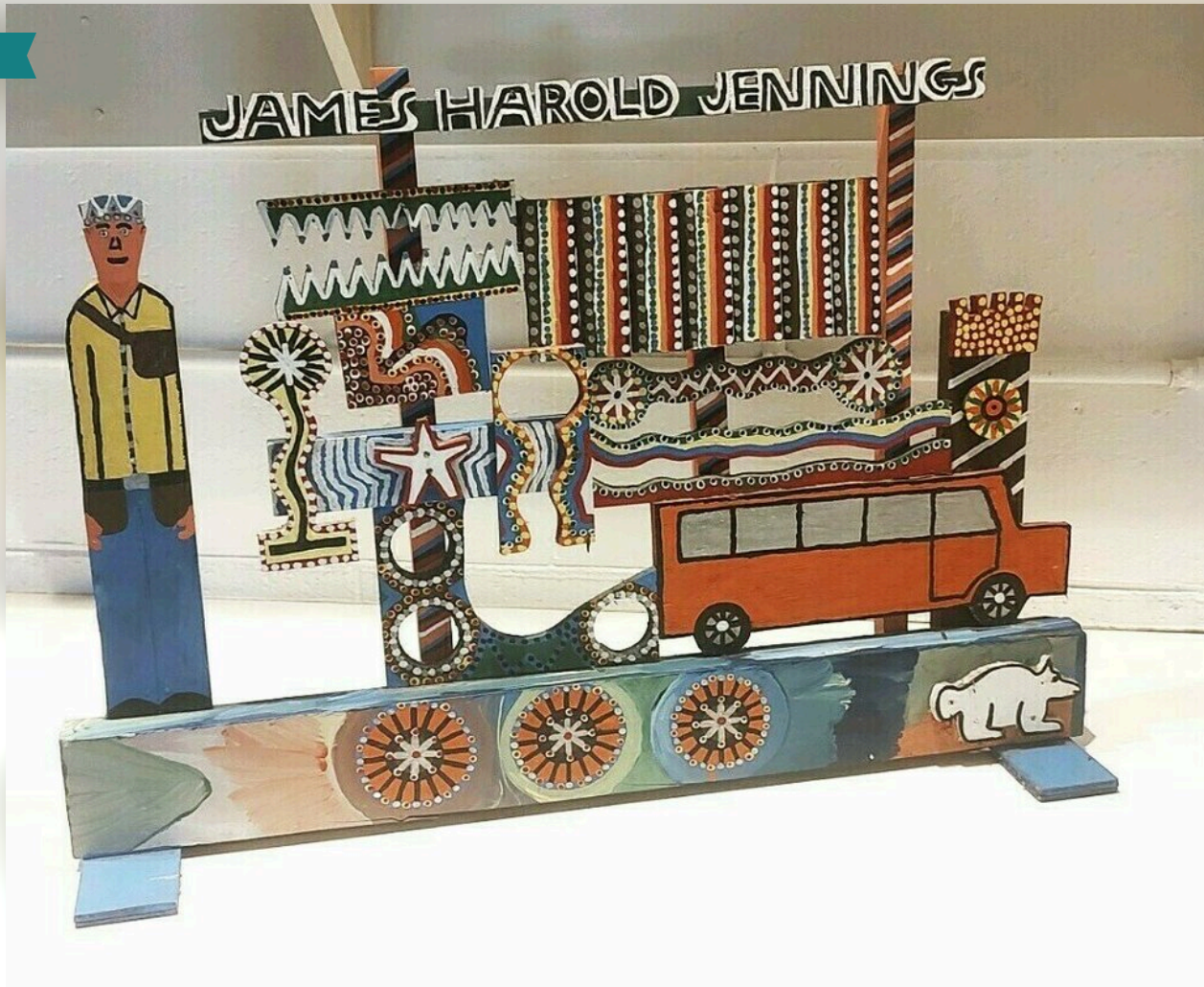

Jennings lived in rural North Carolina. He was taught at home by his school-teacher mother and lived with her in Pinnacle, North Carolina until her death. He was an avid reader.
