

A Taste of Arizona History... Established by cattle baron Edward A. Tovrea in 1919, the Phoenix Stockyards housed nearly 40,000 head of cattle secured by 200 acres of pens, making it the world's largest feedlot. In 1947, The Stockyards Restaurant officially opened on the site and quickly became a favorite gathering place for cattlemen, celebrities, bankers and politicians. By the late 1950s cattle pens gave way to urban growth, but the popularity of Arizona's Original Steakhouse had been established and the restaurant remained intact. In 2004, a visionary team painstakingly restored and revitalized the restaurant and saloon, recapturing the spirit of Arizona's cattle industry and authentic western heritage. Today, the Stockyards is a proud part of the City of Phoenix Historical!
